- 4. The short listed applicants will be interviewed personally, between 10 to 21 February 2020 (date and time to be advised).
- 5. The successful applicant will be notified shortly after 21 February 2020, with the presentation of the award made at a dinner meeting to be held on Wednesday 26th February 2020. The successful applicant is required to attend this evening unless unforeseen circumstances prevent this. In this case, a proxy may stand in for her.
- 6. The successful applicant must show proof that she will be attending the course of study as stipulated in their application, before the award will be presented. If the winner is unable to do this, then the award will pass to the second/third selection and so on.
